

Short-Haul Driver Time Record

HOS time record for U.S. interstate property-carrying operations using 49 CFR 395.1(e)(1).

Carrier / company	Driver name
Normal work reporting location	Week / record period and time zone

Use only when all conditions apply: operate within 150 air-miles of the normal reporting location; return there and be released within 14 consecutive hours; have at least 10 consecutive hours off duty between duty periods. Other driving and cycle limits still apply. The carrier keeps accurate time records for 6 months.

Work date	Report for duty time + AM/PM	Released from duty date / time + AM/PM	Total on-duty hours	Notes / other work

Use the release date for overnight duty. Total on-duty hours includes driving and other on-duty work; do not automatically subtract all breaks.

First-time or intermittent driver prior duty statement

When applicable, provide the total on-duty time for each of the preceding 7 days, including work for other employers, and the time last relieved from duty.

If the short-haul conditions are not met, use the applicable RODS method; paper use requires an applicable ELD exception. Keep continuation records with the same driver and period.
